## Dating Safely



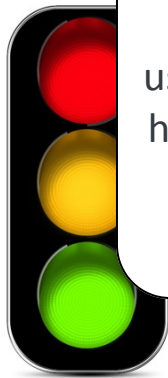
Educators! Looking for new and innovative ways to educate your students on the various kinds of relationship hurdles they face in today's ever-changing interpersonal landscape?

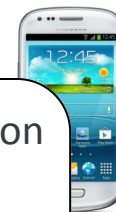
## Beyond No Means No
